Dear Friends:

2010 was a full and challenging year for North Coast Community Homes (NCCH). But we are pleased to report that NCCH has steadfastly met those challenges and advanced our unique mission in the community: to provide safe, accessible and quality homes to persons with disabilities. None of our activities would have occurred without the generous and unswerving support of many individuals in the community. While we invite you to review our entire report, the year's highlights are summarized below.

1. Recognizing that over 80% of home fires start in the kitchen, we began the implementation of a Board directed \$250,000 project to install hood suppression systems over all of our stoves in NCCH properties. We have completed the installation of these systems in all of our Stark and Summit County properties. We hope to complete the final installation of units in the balance of our properties in Cuyahoga and Lake Counties by the end of 2011.
2. We have finally transitioned to an advanced finance and property management software package. Today, our maintenance staff and vehicles are linked to GPS technology to better track and contain our costs directly related to properties.
3. We have dramatically improved our property management program in several ways. We have purchased Blackberry two-way phones for each of our maintenance personnel and with the assistance of the William J. & Dorothy K. O'Neill Foundation now provide each of our maintenance staff with a notebook computer.
4. One residential property was donated by the Pehmoeller family in Strongsville. It has been renovated and three tenants already moved into their new home.
5. We are delighted to announce the appointment of our first Major Gifts Director, Gretchen Greissing, who is already fully occupied in introducing new recruits to the work of NCCH. Planning is well under way for the Home Sweet Homes III benefit on Saturday, September 17, 2011.
6. Our Endowment Fund corpus is growing and has now reached over \$750,000. This crucial project is designed to assure future viability and sustainability as we continue to serve the most vulnerable among us.

We want to thank the government agencies, foundations, corporations and individual donors who make our valuable work possible, as well as the members of our Board of Trustees, staff and tenants.

While we are confident that 2011 will bring fresh challenges, we are equally confident of our agency's ability to positively affect the lives of our vulnerable population and, by doing so, advance our special mission. With your support, we will continue to make a difference!

Property Development & Management

PROGRAM

North Coast Community Homes (NCCH) develops and maintains single family and licensed housing for people with mental retardation and developmental disabilities in partnership with the county boards of developmental disabilities in Cuyahoga, Lake and Stark Counties. In Summit County, multi-family properties are developed and maintained for people diagnosed with severe mental illness in conjunction with The Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board.

2010 DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

North Coast Community Homes acquired three new properties in Cuyahoga County in 2010. One home was donated to NCCH through the generosity of Karen and David Pehmoeller. The Pehmoellers were thanked for their generous gift at the NCCH Annual Meeting by the three women - Tina, Barbara and Carole - who moved into this home.

The other two properties include a licensed home for five tenants and a single family residence for four tenants.

Maintenance continued in all rental properties in 2010, ranging from unplugging toilets to reroofing homes.

Installation of fire suppression systems above the stoves has been completed except for 12 homes that are scheduled for renovation in the near future.

Property Development & Management

COST EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS

A new electronic communications system, funded in part by the William J. & Dorothy K. O'Neill Foundation, was initiated in 2010. This program has enabled maintenance staff members to handle a greater number of work orders in a shorter period of time.

As older maintenance vans require replacement smaller, lighter vans that are more fuel efficient are being purchased.

With the assistance of The Alcohol, Drug Abuse & Mental Health Services Board in Summit County, two full time maintenance staff members have been hired to assist tenants with the upkeep of their apartments. In the past, costly renovations have been needed when tenants in Summit County have moved out of our properties. This new program began at the end of 2010.

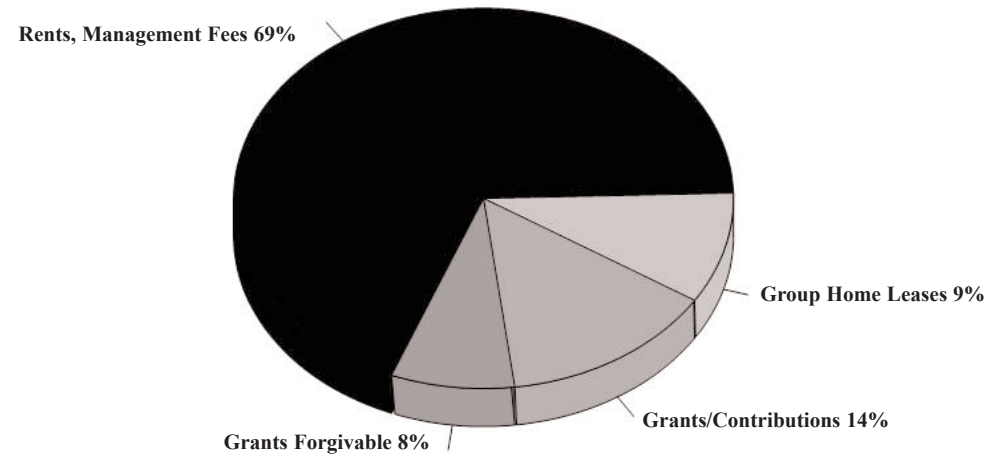

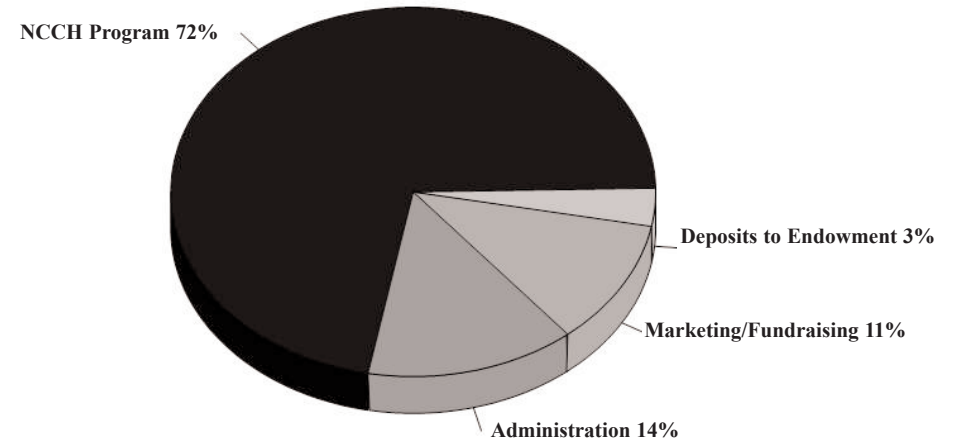

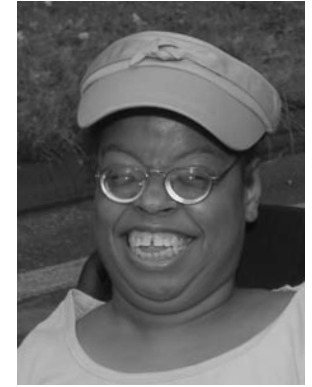
